

**CONDITIONS OF TENDER FOR RETREADING OR RECAPPING OF TYRES FOR  
THE PERIOD FROM 1.4.2024 TO 31.3.2025  
(UNDER CONVENTIONAL / PRECURED PROCESS)**

1. Tenders should be sent in sealed covers superscribed "TENDER FOR RETREADING OR RECAPPING OF TYRES" to reach the Director, Tamil Nadu Motor Vehicles Maintenance Department, Government Central Automobile WorkShop Compound, Velachery, Chennai-600 042 on or before 23-01-2024, 10.45 AM. The application can be received from this office from 21-12-2023 onwards on payment of Rs.590/-, upto 22-01-2024, 2.00 pm .

2. Details and specifications of retreading of tyres required are given in the schedule attached.

3. Separate application should be sent for each branch of the firm and should not be consolidated on one application.

4. The tender should hold good for acceptance for a period of one year from 1-4-2024 to 31-3-2025

5. Amount specified in clause (2) above should be deposited towards Earnest Money along with each tender. This amount will be forfeited if the tenderer does not pay the Security Deposit or does not execute the agreement within the time limit laid down in the clause below. Failing to deposit the Earnest Money will result in summary rejection of the tender.

6. Rates quoted by the firm should be inclusive of GST, repair charges and all other charges, if any, and for free collection and delivery of tyres to various vehicle owning officers in the State. Any revision in rates during the contract period will not be entertained.

7. The accepted tenderer should deposit Rs.5000/- (Rupees five thousand only) as Security Deposit in the form of Demand Draft in favour of the Director, Tamil Nadu Motor Vehicles Maintenance Department, Chennai-42 or to furnish an existence certificate issued by the competent authority of the Department of Industries and Commerce, Government of Tamil Nadu, if the firm has been registered permanently under S.S.I. Act for fulfilment of the Contract. The accepted tenderer shall also

execute a written agreement within 15 days from the date of communication of the acceptance of tender in an appropriate stamped paper with the Director of Tamil Nadu Motor Vehicles Maintenance Department, for the execution of work of retreading and recapping of tyres.

8. No claims shall lie against the Director, Tamil Nadu Motor Vehicles Maintenance Department, in respect of interest on security Deposit or E.M.D.

9. The Earnest Money Deposit of Rs.1000/- (Rupees one thousand only) should be paid in the form of crossed Demand Draft drawn in favour of Director, Tamil Nadu Motor Vehicles Maintenance Department, Chennai-600 042 on or after the date of notification.

10. Rates quoted will be taken to be as per item 6 of the conditions of tender, unless specifically stated or otherwise in the tender itself.

11. If the accepted tenderer fails to provide the Security Deposit within the period specified, such failure will not only involve the forfeiture of the Earnest Money deposited by him, but will constitute breach of the contract and the Director, Tamil Nadu Motor Vehicles Maintenance Department shall be entitled to make other arrangements for executing these works at the risk and expense of the tenderer.

12. If the accepted tenderer fails to execute the work of retreading and recapping of tyres, the Director, Tamil Nadu Motor Vehicles Maintenance Department will be entitled to get the work executed elsewhere at the risk of the accepted tenderer. The accepted tenderer shall be liable to compensate any loss which the vehicle owning officer may sustain on this account but the tenderer shall not be entitled to any gain on such execution of work.

13. The tender is for execution of work commencing for the period from 1-4-2024 to 31-3-2025. The vehicle-owning officer shall be entitled before placing firm orders to reduce or increase the total quantity to the extent necessary in each description of work in the schedule.

14. The Director, Tamil Nadu Motor Vehicles Maintenance Department, does not bind himself to accept the lowest of any offer and reserves the right to himself to reject the tender without assigning any reason therefore.

15. The tender should be accompanied by a declaration that work would be executed in whole within the time limit as may be decided by the Director, Tamil Nadu Motor Vehicles Maintenance Department in accordance with the above terms and conditions.

## **SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

1. The firm should have been registered under Factories Act or registered as Small Scale Industries.

2. The firm or its branches/franchisers as the case may be should have been in the tyre retreading field continuously for a period of not less than three years immediately prior to the date of advertisement. Collection centres will not be considered as branches.

3. Rates quoted should be firm inclusive of GST repair charges and all other charges. The tyres should be collected from the Vehicle-Owning Officers and delivered back to them and no charge should be levied for this purpose.

4. The work will be entrusted as and when required by the concerned officers and the work should be executed and the tyres entrusted should be delivered after retreading/recapping within 15 days from the date of receipt, failing which a penalty of Rs.25/- per day will be collected from the date of default.

5. The contract will be in force for a period of one financial year (i.e. from 1-4-2024 to 31-3-2025)

6. A sum of Rs.1000/- (Rupees one thousand only) shall be deposited towards Earnest Money against this tender in the manner indicated in the conditions of tender. Tenders without Earnest Money Deposit will be summarily rejected. The Earnest Money or Security Deposit paid by the tenderer in connection with some other tender will not be treated as Earnest Money or Security Deposit against this tender.

7. Tenders will be received up-to -10.45 AM on 23-01-2024. Belated tenders will be summarily rejected.

8. Tenders received will be opened before the tenderers on 23-01-2024 at 11-00 A.M.

9. The accepted tenderer will have to execute an agreement with this department in the approved form, which will be sent separately.

10. The firm to be approved should undertake to guarantee for the following Kilometer age performance as a minimum.

11. This Department / Tender Inviting Authority reserves the right to reject any offer in their opinion in which the rate quoted is considered to be high. Under such circumstances this Department will make alternate arrangement to carryout the work of retreading in a District either by diverting such work to the neighbouring District or by extending the existing contract.

12. The contract will be in force for a period from 1-4-2024 to 31-3-2025 This contract will be extendable for a further period of 6 months in full or part thereof if agreed by this department and the contractor.

13. This department's representative will undertake a surprise inspection of the tyre retreading firm in the respect of infra-structure, floor space, plant machineries and equipments. During the inspection retreading firm/ proprietor shall ensure that a responsible person will be present during the normal working hour and he shall be instructed to countersign the inspection report for and on behalf of the proprietor / firm. Refused to countersign or abstraction to inspection shall result in disqualification of the firm / retreader.

14. Arbitration Clause: In the case of any dispute connected with any matter covered in this conditions and/or the contract shall be referred to the Sole Arbitration of the Government or its nominee whose decision shall be final and binding on the parties. The provision of the arbitration Act shall apply to the adjudication of all such dispute.

Such agreement is subject to Chennai jurisdiction notwithstanding pendency of any dispute, the contractors shall, carry out the Motor Vehicles Maintenance Department's requirement and / or continue to make the contract as ordered.

15. The Tender deciding authority reserves the right to accept or reject the tender without assigning any reason thereon.
